They will be required to complete an application, provide proof of insurance, a copy of their license(s), if applicable, and pay an annual fee. Even if the contractor registered with the Village in 2010, they need to register again for 2011. Please make sure your contractors have a 2011 permit or advise them to visit the Village office to obtain a permit.

Dorothy was born November 22, 1910 in White Hall, Illinois to Warren L. Osborne and Amy Kundig Osborne. Dorothy lived in White Hall, New Berlin, Canton, and then moved back to New Berlin where she graduated from high school.

Dorothy graduated from Passavant School of Nursing in Jacksonville, Illinois in 1937 and worked in the nursing profession for more than 73 years at various hospitals, nursing homes and then retired after 20 years at the Illinois Presbyterian Home. Dorothy recently attended an alumni event and was honored as the oldest living member of the Passavant School of Nursing .

Dorothy has traveled widely, including trips to Switzerland, England, Scotland, Ireland, Norway, Sweden, Denmark, and even spent three days in Russia. In addition, she traveled to China, Japan, New Zealand , Australia and Egypt and took a cruise that included a visit to Israel and Jerusalem.

This amazing woman earned her Bachelor's degree in Family and Community Service from Sangamon State University when she was 83 years old. On October 29th Dorothy was inducted into the Sigma Phi Omega – Eta Chapter of the National Academic Honor & Professional Society in Gerontology.

Dorothy has lived in Jerome since 1952, when she moved here with her parents. She was a member of Eastern Star for over 72 years and is still active at St. John's Lutheran Church.
