A MESSAGE FROM YOUR WATER DEPARTMENT



Water bills are to be paid on a monthly basis.

If a bill for two months' water usage has been mailed, the entire two month bill must be paid by the due date shown on the bill. If the two month bill is not paid by the required date, water service will be shut off and a \$50.00 fee for a delinquent bill will be charged.

Water service can be restored between 7:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, and only after payment of the delinquent bill and the \$50.00 fee is paid. Remember, it is your responsibility to pay your water bill in a timely manner in accordance with the Village ordinance.

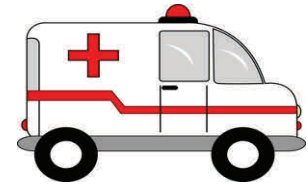

Trick-Or-Treat Night

Homes that are passing out treats should turn on their porch light to let children know they are welcome at their home.

To ensure that your children enjoy this Halloween safely, please follow these safety rules:

Make sure that you accompany your children on their trick-or-treat route.

Teach your children to stop only at houses or apartment buildings that are well lit and never to enter a stranger's home. You may want to consider only trick-or-treating at the homes of people you know.

Insist that treats be brought home for inspection before anything is eaten.

When in doubt, throw the treat out.

Review trick-or-treat safety precautions with your children, including pedestrian and traffic safety rules.

Pin a slip of paper with the child's name, address and phone number inside a pocket in case the youngster gets separated from the group.

Make sure costumes are fire retardant. If your child is wearing a mask remember that masks can obstruct your child's vision. If masks are worn, they should have nose and mouth openings and large eyeholes.

Carrying flashlights will help children see better and be seen more clearly by others.

Walk; do not run, from house to house. Do not cross lawns and yards where unseen objects or the uneven terrain can cause you to fall.

Walk on the left side of the road, facing traffic.
