

Public Works Laborer

The Public Works Laborer is a full-time position located in the Village of Jerome, a small community (approx. 1600) in the central part of the State of Illinois. The Public Works Laborer must have a CDL license and will perform a variety of tasks including but not limited to:

- Works with Supervisor to maintains street, property, and water system.
- Receives works assignments from Supervisor for various departments.
- Handles various work assignments, including but not limited to monthly meter readings, limb pick up, street repair, water main break repair, etc.
- Assists with inventory of all equipment, materials, and supplies.
- Assures that buildings and grounds are in good condition for scheduled events in the Village.
- In certain instances, may be called upon by the Supervisor during emergency situations within the village. For example, water main breaks or snow plowing.

The Public Works Laborer will receive health insurance, retirement benefits (IMRF), and paid days off and holidays.
